BIOGRAPHY

Meg Miller is a Scottish artist and beekeeper based on the Isle of Skye. Following a long career as a textile designer, maker and educator, she graduated with First Class Honours in Contemporary Art Practice from Gray's School of Art, Robert Gordon University.

Her background in textiles and skilled making continues to inform her art practice, with a particular interest in material, surface, texture and process.

Living and working between the Red and Black Cuillin ranges, Miller is closely connected to the island landscape and the changing environments around her. Shoreline, woodland, hill ground, garden and apiary are part of her everyday surroundings.

Beekeeping has become an important part of her practice, alongside walking and close observation of the natural environment.

Miller has exhibited throughout Scotland and internationally. In 2025 she exhibited in SEA(S), an international group exhibition at the Ionian Centre for Arts and Culture in Kefalonia, Greece. In 2026 she returned to the centre for the Guthan na Mara / Sea Voices Residency and participated in SEA(S) RESONANCE, an international exhibition bringing together artists from the Isle of Skye and Kefalonia.
